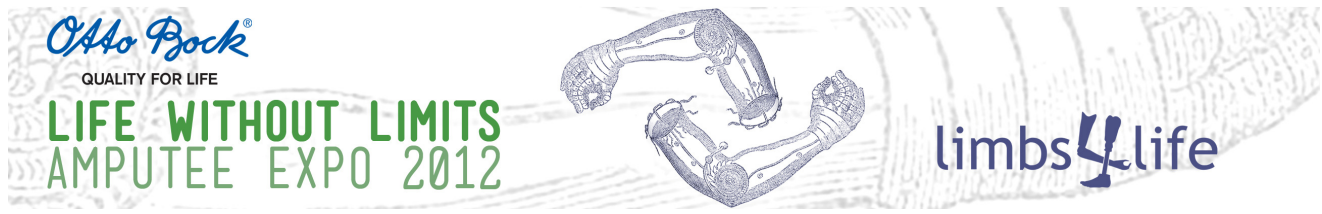

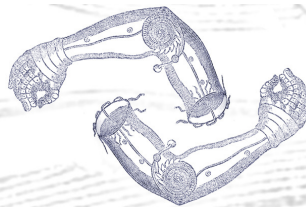

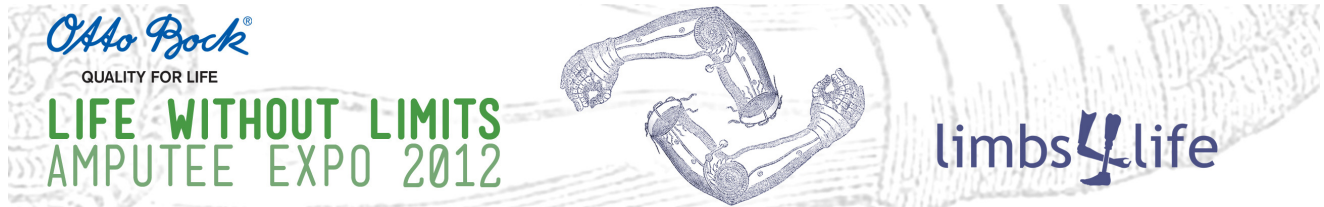
Expo Venue and Getting There

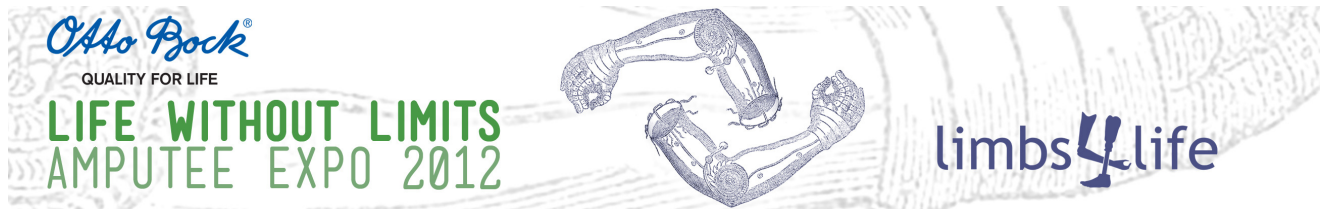
